




















Step	Clear Chrome cache (Chrome version: 75.0.3770.142 or above)

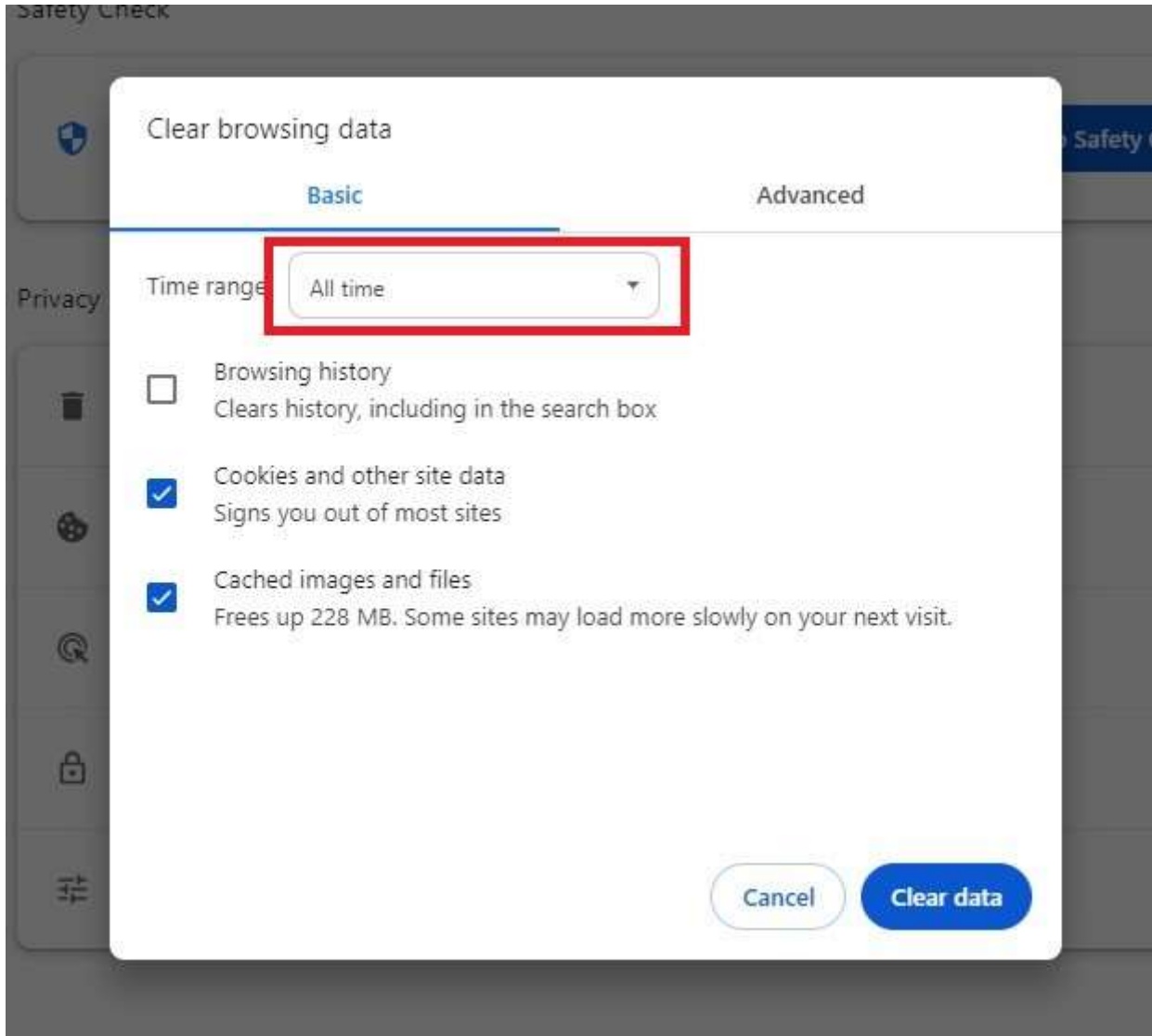
